

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH EDUCATION LOGISTICS, INC. FOR SOFTWARE PROGRAMMING AND CONSULTING SERVICES AND THE OPTION TO LICENSE ADDITIONAL EDULOG SOFTWARE MODULES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Education Logistics, Inc. for software programming and consulting services and the option to license additional Edulog software modules by the Bureau of Student Transportation and Capital Planning and Demographics at a cost not to exceed \$220,000. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because it is the licensor of Edulog routing, scheduling and boundary planning software which has been utilized by the Board since 1994. A written agreement for Consultant's

services is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Consultant and no payment shall be made to Consultant prior to the execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall
