

APPROVE HEARING OFFICER'S FINDING THAT RURI IS A NON-RESIDENT

ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS

OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING: ID No. 39910799

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

That the Chicago Board of Education (the Board) find on the basis of the facts that the hearing officer has found that Ruri is a non-resident of the City of Chicago and is not a resident of the City of Chicago for the purposes of the Chicago Public Schools Act, Chapter 12-20, Illinois Compiled Statutes (CS), and that the Board is authorized to charge \$4,400.13 per year for non-resident student tuition for the 1998-1999 and 1999-2000 school years; (2) bar the pupil from attending the Chicago Public Schools as otherwise allowed by Rule 5.13 of the Rules of the Board; and (3) after due consideration of the objections to the hearing officer's October 31, 2000 findings (ID No. 39910799) filed by the parent of the pupil (ID No. 39910799).

DESCRIPTION:

Chicago Public Schools (CPS) is a public school district that provides educational services to approximately 1.2 million students in the City of Chicago. CPS is authorized to charge tuition for non-resident students who are enrolled in its schools. The cost of maintaining its schools during the preceding school year to pupils enrolled in the Chicago Public Schools determined to be non-residents of the City of Chicago. Further, section 10-20.12b provides that a hearing be held when requested by the person who enrolled the pupil in a Chicago Public School District (CPS) if, after notice of the initial determination of non-residency, the person who enrolled the pupil does not request a hearing or, if requested, the hearing results in a finding that the pupil does not reside in the City of Chicago.
