GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General: Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 U.S.C.

5104-10-4, the Inspector General of the Ohio State Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Confidentiality: The agreement shall include a provision that the Board and its members shall not disclose the provisions of 105 U.S.C. 5104-21.3 which restricts the employment of, by the Board of Education, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.
