GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General -- Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34.13-1 the Janney-Carroll of the Board of Trustees has the authority to make and execute any agreement on behalf of the Board of Trustees that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts -- The agreement shall not be legal binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34.2-13 which restricts the employment of former Board members.

Indebtedness -- The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726 EX2) as amended from time to time shall apply to this agreement.
