

APPROVE EXERCISING THE 2ND OPTION TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT

WITH SMITHKLINE BEECHAM PHARMACEUTICALS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

and the agreement with SmithKline Beecham Pharmaceuticals to provide Bloodborne Pathogens consulting services to the Department of Human Resources, Bureau of Employee Health Services at a cost for the option period not to exceed \$792,000.00. A written document exercising this option is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Consultant during the option period prior to the execution of the written document. The agreement shall remain in effect until the date of the written document or until not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. BR 00-0726-PR27 is the first ORIGINAL AGREEMENT entered into with the Board commencing March 1, 2000 and ending July 31, 2000 with the Board having two options to renew the agreement. The first option was exercised for one year (authorized by BR 00-0726-PR26), for the term of 365 days commencing July 01, 2000 at the amount of \$792,000.00 and commencing August 1, 2000 and ending July 31, 2001, in the amount of \$792,000.00 and ending July 31, 2002, in the amount of \$792,000.00.

OPTION PERIOD: The agreement is being renewed for 1 year commencing August 1, 2000 and ending July 31, 2002.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Consultant shall continue to provide training; administer Hepatitis B vaccine; assist with record keeping; create procedures for post-exposure evaluations; follow-ups and reporting, and any other duties as specified in the agreement.

DELIVERABLES: Consultant shall continue to provide training in accordance with the final Exposure Control Plan to all employees who are identified as at risk or any exposed. Make a parapneumothorax profile program and arrange handling of regulated medical waste disposal.

OBJECTIVES: Chicago Public Schools will come into compliance with the Bloodborne Pathogens Standard when in a regulation of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration and The Illinois Department of Labor.

COMPENSATION: During the option period SmithKline Beecham shall be paid at the same rate as in the original agreement, with the maximum compensation payable of \$792,000.00.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to execute the option document. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the option document.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Vendor agrees to comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprise economic Participation (M/WBE Plan).

LSC REVIEW: Local School Council approval is not applicable to this report.
