2002 IASA Title I, Title II, Title IV, Title VI, and Class-Size Reduction programs for fiscal 2002. The purpose of this document is to provide information to the Illinois State Board of Education regarding the submission of proposals for these programs. The following information is provided for your information: Title I, Title II, Title IV, Title VI, and Class-Size Reduction proposals to the Illinois State Board of Education.

**DESCRIPTION:
IASA TITLE I**

The main goal of Title I is to improve educational opportunities for children who are at risk of failing public and nonpublic schools. Approximately 120 nonpublic schools also receive Title I services. More than 300,000 nonpublic school pupils may participate in the fiscal 2002 project.

The goals of the Title I, Title IV, and Class-Size Reduction projects support services for more than 430,000 public school children and more than 80,000 nonpublic school children in Chicago. Following is a brief description of each of the four projects:

IASA TITLE II

The purpose of the Title II program is to provide professional development activities for teachers in those critical curricular areas. Local schools will design the professional development activities that will best meet their needs.

IASA TITLE IV

The purpose of the Title IV program is to provide professional development activities for teachers in Chicago's public and nonpublic schools. The purpose of this program is to create a comprehensive...
