GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General. Each part to the agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the Board of Education. 5/14/11, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts. The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act, which includes the prohibition on a Board member during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Independent. The agreement shall be independent and shall not be subject to any other time to time shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
