Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-2.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel to conduct those investigations.

The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-2.1.6 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former board member during the one year period following expiration of the term of office of such board member.
