

RATIFY AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CHICAGO - DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL ARTS FOR THE GALLERY 37 CENTER ARTS PROJECT

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Ratify an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Chicago, Department of Cultural Arts for the Gallery 37 Center Arts Project.
