RATIFY AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
THE CITY OF CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL ARTS FOR THE
GALLERY 37 CENTER ARTS PROJECT

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Ratify an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Chicago Department of Cultural Arts for the Gallery 37 Center Arts Project. This agreement was originally signed on June 22, 1999 for a three-year period and approved. A written intergovernmental agreement was signed on June 22, 2000 for a three-year period. The Office of Education to Careers has been informed that the program will be continued without prior board approval. The written intergovernmental agreement is available for signature. The contract carried forward for the 2000-2001 school year. The Office of Education to Careers has been informed that a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the original agreement's expiration date, the original agreement remains in effect. PROJECT: The Gallery 37 Center provides a unique opportunity for selected high school juniors and seniors to gain practical experience in the arts through internships at local arts organizations. Interns receive training in various areas of the arts, including fine arts, professional theater, film, media, and music. Interns also receive guidance in developing their resumes and job search skills.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:
