Section 3 - Appeal Hearings.

The amendments to this section include:

- procedures by which parties can appeal a decision made by the Executive Director of the CPHSAA;
- schedules for requesting an appeal, the conduct of appeal hearings by the Executive Board of the CPHSAA, and the issuance of written findings by the Executive Board.

requirements that if the issue under appeal could have an adverse effect on a student-athlete and his or her parents or guardians, the student-athlete, the student-athlete's representative, his or her parents or guardians, or an appropriate representative must have an opportunity to present information that is relevant and material to the issue under appeal.
