ORIGINAL AGREEMENT

The original agreement for additional one-year periods commencing July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2000. The Agreement was renewed by mutual consent in the amount of \$75,000, for a term commencing July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001, and that Renewal Agreement contained 2 options to renew the Agreement for additional one-year periods commencing July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002.

PERIODS REMAINING: There is one option period remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Saint Xavier University will continue to provide consultation, support and training to staff, and community at the Barbara Vick Early Childhood and Family Center. Saint Xavier University will continue to train the Center's faculty in the areas of teaching family and community relationships, opportunities for research and professional development, and supervise students who are training at the center preparation programs.

DELIVERABLES: Consultant will continue to provide weekly staff training; ongoing technical assistance practices in early childhood education, additional staff via university students completing education, and nursing or pathologists training.

OUTCOMES: Consultant's services during the renewal period will result in the center being a model for students with significant disabilities who are in the same classrooms with non-disabled peers; a model site where parents
