

RATIFY ENTERING INTO AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS CONSULTANTS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

That it is recommended that the following consultants be authorized to provide environmental engineering and

professional services to the Department of Operations for the Capital Improvement Program at a cost not to exceed \$5,035,600 in the aggregate for the first year and \$5,035,600 in the aggregate for the second year.

These consultants were selected pursuant to publicly advertised Requests for Qualifications/Proposals (See

No. 01-250099). A written agreement for each Consultant's services is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to any Consultant prior to the execution of such Consultant's written agreement.

If a written agreement is not executed by such Consultant within 90 days of the date of this Board Report, information regarding such Consultant's status shall be reported to the Board of Supervisors in the next Board Report.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and persons necessary to conduct these investigations.

The agreement shall contain the provision on the prohibition on the use of funds in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/14.7, which restricts the employment of the term "contracts" members during the one year period following expiration or termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board and the Office of the Inspector General shall be bound by the terms of the agreement.

Adopted September 27, 1995 (85-0927-PL12) as amended from time to time. The Board's Ethics Code is hereby incorporated into and made a part of this agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year shall be subject to the Board's Budget Committee's review.
