APPROVE HEARING OFFICER'S FINDING THAT PUPIL WAS A NON-RESIDENT OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO NOT ENTITLED TO ATTEND THE CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS DURING THE 2000-2001 SCHOOL YEAR.

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Chicago Board of Education (1) adopt the findings of fact of the Board-appointed Hearing Officer, from a Pupil Residency Hearing held on August 8, 2001, that: (i) the pupil (ID No. 40119884) was a non-resident of the City of Chicago not entitled to attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis during the 2000-2001 school year; and (ii) that the Board is authorized and empowered to charge \$5,568.18 as and for non-resident student tuition for the pupil's attendance in the Chicago Public Schools as of and for the 2000-2001 school year; and (2) consider, reject the objections to the hearing officer's findings filed by the parent of the
