The Noetix Views software has been selected as part of the Board's end-user reporting strategy. A written agreement for consulting services is currently being negotiated. No payment is to be made to Noetix, Inc. for the consulting services until the agreement is executed. This agreement is to be executed within ninety (90) days of the date of this Board Report.
