This license agreement shall be one (1) year and nine (9) months and shall commence on **TERM:** the term of October 1, 2001 and end June 30, 2002-2003.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time, providing thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

USE: The above Premises shall be used by Licensee on Sundays from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. for church services.

INSURANCE: Licensee will name the Board of Education as an additional named insured under its Comprehensive General Liability Policy. Licensee will provide a Certificate of Insurance naming the Board as an additional insured with the provision that the Board be provided 30 days prior written notice of cancellation, amendment, or non-renewal.

Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written license agreement. **AUTHORIZATION:** Approved by the Board of Education.

FINANCIAL: Income to be credited to the Wendel Phillips High School. **OPERATION & MAINTENANCE:** The Board will be responsible for normal maintenance of the space.
