Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of any agreement.

The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-BU2), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of any agreement.

Contingent Liability – Any agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year shall be deemed a contingent liability subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year.
