

ADOPT BOARD RULE 6-32, CHANGE OF AN ATTENDANCE CENTER'S LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTION DATE

THE GENERAL COUNSEL RECOMMENDS:

The General Counsel recommends adopting Board Rule 6-32 as follows:

DESCRIPTION:

Upon the recommendation of the General Superintendent, the Board may change the date of the first semester report card pick-up day to increase parents' and community involvement as candidates and electors. If the Board adopts the General Superintendent's recommendation concerning the new biennial local school council election date, the Superintendent shall advise the Board of the date of the first semester report card pick-up day to increase parents' and community involvement as candidates and electors. If the Board adopts the General Superintendent's recommendation concerning the new biennial local school council election date, the Superintendent shall advise the Board of the date of the first semester report card pick-up day to increase parents' and community involvement as candidates and electors.

Residents

of the attendance center's attendance boundaries; or, where applicable, local school council voting boundaries; grade structure; or any other circumstance that would preclude the attendance center from enrolling students eligible to attend the attendance center in the next full term. The Board may deny the parents or legal guardians the next full term opportunity to participate as either candidates or electors. In any event, the Board may deny the local school council election for the attendance center or from the center on the students' anticipated enrollment in the attendance center.

The Board may adopt the General Superintendent's recommendation pursuant to its authority under Sections 5/34-2.1(n) and 5/34-18 of the Illinois School Code, respectively, to conduct fair and moral local school council elections and to exercise general supervision and jurisdiction over the Chicago Public Schools. 105 IL CS 5/34-2.1(n); 5/34-18 (2000).
