GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General -- Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-1, the Inspector General of the Board of Trustees has the authority to conduct certain investigations and shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts -- The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-1 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness -- The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3) as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics -- The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3) as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.
