

ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO THE OFFICE OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

As the Board of Education of the City of Chicago empowered and directed its personnel to collaborate with early childhood organizations and to establish an Early Childhood Advisory Committee allowing the full expression of the views, opinions and expectations of that body and that

Advisory Committee will ensure the involvement of concerned parties and advocates in Early Childhood Education, and serve in an advisory capacity to the Office of

WHEREAS, the Early Childhood Advisory Committee will consist of members appointed from children's agencies and organizations, university researchers and Early Childhood advocates, groups; and

On November 25, 2000, Board Report 00-1025-RS8 authorized the appointment of a two-year term on the Early Childhood Advisory Committee to the Office of

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2000, the Board of Education authorized the appointment of eleven members to the Early Childhood Education Advisory Committee; and

On February 21, 2001, Board Report 01-0221-RS7 authorized changing the Early Childhood Education Advisory Committee from eleven members to fifteen members and approved the

WHEREAS, the Early Childhood Education Advisory Committee shall consist of fifteen members, including four academic members, two-year terms and increase the term of the Advisory Committee; and
