**THE GENERAL COUNSEL REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Continued retention of the law firm Kane Laduzinsky & Mendoza, Ltd.

Continued retention of the law firm Kane Laduzinsky & Mendoza, Ltd. was previously authorized by the Board of Education (Case No. 02-LI-7582). While no further legal services will be provided by the law firm, the General Counsel anticipates the continuation of ongoing legal services in connection with the administration of the Estate of Derrick Spencer, which has been filed in the New York County Court. The total amount of fees to be paid to the law firm for services rendered up to the present time is \$80,000. As invoices are received, payment will be made to the law firm by the Board of Education. Additional authorization for the firm's fees is requested in the amount of \$80,000. This amount is to be paid to the law firm by the Board of Education upon satisfactory completion of payment of the initial amount of \$80,000. The law firm will be retained by the General Counsel for the duration of the estate administration.
