ORIGINAL AGREEMENT:

The original Professional Services Agreement authorized under Board Report 99-250325 was for a term commencing July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2000 with the Board having the option to renew for 6 months for one year periods. The 1st option was exercised for one year commencing July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001 in the amount of \$1,800,000. The 2nd option was exercised for one year commencing July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002 in the amount of \$1,800,000. The original agreement was awarded on a competitive basis.

OPTION PERIOD: The agreement is being renewed for 1 year commencing July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003.

SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR THE 1ST OPTION PERIOD:

Consultant shall continue to provide occupational health services including random drug and alcohol testing for truck drivers on-site physicals at the end of shift, additional services for duty testing, and post-exposure follow-ups as defined by (IDOL) Bloodborne Pathogens Standard.
