GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC PRESENTATION

The Chicago Board of Education is committed to increasing public input in its decision-making process. That commitment is addressed in the procedures for public participation at Board meetings, as outlined below. Board Members also encourage input in the education and reform process through a variety of other channels, including local school council meetings; Local School Council Advisory Board meetings; Academic Accountability Council meetings; public hearings; Board committee

meetings; local and regional PTA meetings; and through written communication directly to Board Members (addressed to: Board Office, 125 South Clark Street, 6th Floor, Chicago, Illinois 60603)

The Public Participation portion of the Board's regularly scheduled meetings will be conducted between 10:30 A.M. and 12:30 P.M. prior to each daytime meeting and between 4:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. for every evening meeting. Any individual interested in making a presentation must register with the Office of the Board, in person, between 8:00 A.M. and 9:30 A.M. on the day of the daytime meeting, and between 1:30 P.M. and 3:00 P.M. on the day of the evening meeting.
