

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL STUDENT CLEARINGHOUSE FOR DIPLOMA VERIFICATION AND POSTSECONDARY ENROLLMENT TRACKING SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with the National Student Clearinghouse ("Clearinghouse") to provide diploma verification and postsecondary enrollment tracking services to the Office of High School Programs at a cost not to exceed \$157,839.00 for a five-year term. The Clearinghouse shall be paid as follows: (1) For the first three years of the agreement, \$325/high school; (2) for the last two years of the agreement, an amount not to exceed \$425/high school; (3) Total compensation for the 5-year term of the agreement will not exceed \$157,839.00. Clearinghouse was selected on a non-competitive basis because it currently has a database that

Enrollment Search Clearinghouse will provide verified postsecondary enrollment data for GDS graduates in an

electronic file. Data will include:

- initial enrolled status
- highest enrolled status
- postsecondary institution
- type of institution
- college graduation status
- type of degree
- college major
- enrollment history, including transfers

OUTCOMES: Clearinghouse's services shall result in the following outcomes:
