**APPROVE HEARING OFFICER'S FINDING THAT PUPIL IS A NON-RESIDENT  
OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO NOT ENTITLED TO ATTEND CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS  
ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

That the Chicago Board of Education: (i) adopt the July 6, 2004, findings of fact of the Board-appointed Hearing Officer from a Pupil Residency Hearing held June 15, 2004, that: since August 2002, the pupil (ID No. 41604122) has been a non-resident of the City of Chicago, not entitled to

attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis; and that the parents of the pupil are indebted to the Board for non-resident tuition for the pupil's attendance in the Chicago Public Schools from September 2003 to June 2004 while a non-resident of the City of Chicago in the amount of \$2,470.05; (ii) find that the pupil is not entitled to attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis.


