

**RATIFY ENTERING INTO AGREEMENTS OR RENEWALS WITH  
HEARING OFFICERS FOR EXPULSION, TRUANCY, TUITION RESIDENCY,  
AND BOARD RULE 6-28, 6-29, AND 6-30 HEARINGS**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

*Ratify entering into agreements or renewals with the individual hearing officers listed below to provide*

*hearing officer services to the Office of Institutions and School Management and the Law Department of a*

**EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:** The agreements may be terminated by the Board upon 15 calendar days notice of default to the hearing officers, provided that the hearing officers do not cure during such 15 day period.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:** Each hearing officer shall act as a hearing officer for student expulsion hearings, truancy hearings, or tuition residency hearings, as assigned by the General Counsel or her designee.

**DELIVERABLES:** Each hearing officer shall prepare a written summary of the evidence taken at the hearings, together with a recommendation, and forward that summary to the appropriate department.

**OUTCOMES:** The hearing officer shall submit a written report to the Chief Education Officer on

her designee.

**COMPENSATION:** For expulsion and truancy hearings, the hearing officers shall be paid as follows:

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, is hereby incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

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Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal
