COMPENSATION: Each Provider will be paid a negotiated rate for services rendered, as detailed in each Providers Agreement; Compensation not to exceed \$600,000 in the aggregate.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Council to include other relevant terms and conditions in the

written agreements. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreements. Authorize the Chief Specialized Services Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate
