

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
OMICRON TECHNOLOGIES FOR SCHOOL KEY CARD SYSTEMS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Omicron Technologies ("Omicron") for the purchase of software

selected on a non-competitive basis because of Omicron's expertise in developing and implementing school-based key card systems and their strategic position with Chancery Student Management System. A written
