FOR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES FOR EXPULSED STUDENTS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into agreements with the various schools identified below to provide educational services to CBS

students who have been expelled from school or referred by the building principal for displaying chronic disruptive behaviors at a cost not to exceed ~~\$302,475.00~~ \$625,482 in the aggregate. These schools were selected on a non-competitive basis because of their low rates for these services and the Board's need for these services. A written

TERM: The term of each agreement shall commence on September 1, 2003 and shall end August 31, 2005 with the Board having 2 options to renew for periods of 1 year each.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Each school will offer comprehensive educational services to youth in grades 9-12 who have been chronically suspended or expelled in accordance with the CPS Uniform Discipline Code. Each school shall have a special curriculum that focuses on core academic subjects, social skills and education to

career options. Each school will enhance their educational capacity through the implementation of instruction through the use of technology.

DELIVERABLES: Each school will submit the following: a) monthly attendance reports; b) quarterly grade reports;
