

**RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN "SPECIAL NEEDS" AREAS
FOR THE 2005-2006 SCHOOL YEAR
PURSUANT TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION'S RESIDENCY POLICY**

WHEREAS the Chicago Board of Education ("Board") has the power to require its employees to

be residents of the City of Chicago pursuant to Section 34-83.1 of the Illinois School Code (105 ILCS 5/34-83.1);

WHEREAS, the Board has the power under Section 34-18 of the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/34-18, to promulgate rules establishing procedures regarding the residence of its employees;

WHEREAS, the Board, pursuant to the above articulated powers, promulgated its Residency
