

**APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT WITH  
ALL PRINTING & GRAPHICS, INC.

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve exercising the first option to renew the agreement with All Printing & Graphics, Inc. for the purchase of Reprographic and Printing services for the central office departments, Area Instruction Offices and schools at an

aggregate cost for the option period not to exceed \$2,000,000.00. A written document exercising this option is currently being negotiated. No goods may be received and no payment shall be made to this Vendor prior to the execution of the

**OUTCOMES:** Vendor's services will continue to result in fixed prices for printing/reprographic services.

**COMPENSATION:** Vendor will provide services at the prices specified in the renewal agreement and shall be paid as periodic invoices are submitted; total compensation not to exceed \$2,000,000.00

**AUTHORIZATION:** Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written

renewal agreement. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the renewal agreement. Authorize the Chief Purchasing Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this renewal agreement.

**AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:** This contract is in full compliance with the goals required by the Sheltered Market Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprise Contract Participation.

~~Contingent Liability. The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year~~


is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).


