For Public Building Commission Operating and Maintenance Levies as described in Section 1 of this Certificate	\$ 335,000,000
For Liability Protection Purposes as described in Section 1 of this Certificate	\$ 135,000,000

shall be taken solely from the extension for Educational Purposes, except as subsequently

directed by the Controller
