

RESCIND BOARD REPORT 96-0124-ED14 GUIDELINES FOR TEACHING FAMILY LIFE AND AIDS

**EDUCATION IN THE CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND ADOPT A NEW FAMILY LIFE AND
COMPREHENSIVE SEXUAL HEALTH EDUCATION POLICY**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That the Board of Education for the City of Chicago (the "Board") rescind Board Report 96-0124-ED14 Guidelines for Teaching Family Life and AIDS Education in the Chicago Public Schools and adopt a new Family Life and Comprehensive Sexual Health Education Policy ("Policy").

POLICY TEXT:

I. Purpose and Goals

Consistent with the Federal and State laws enacted to address the need for students to receive comprehensive health education, this Policy is intended to ensure that the system offers students a






