

**RESOLUTION HONORING MICHAEL W. SCOTT, PRESIDENT
CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION**

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor of the City of Chicago Richard M. Daley appointed Michael W. Scott to serve as President of the Chicago Board of Education on June 27, 2001; and

WHEREAS, in June 2001, Michael W. Scott was elected to the position of President of the Chicago Board of Education by his fellow Board Members; and

WHEREAS, after five years of distinguished service, Michael W. Scott has resigned as President of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, the Chicago Board of Education achieved several significant and noteworthy accomplishments including the highest test score gains for elementary school students since Mayor Daley received control of the Chicago Public Schools in 1995, with over 60 percent of the students meeting or achieving state

standards in reading, mathematics and science on the 2006 *Illinois Standards Achievement Test*; and
