

**APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT

- Provide management staff that includes but are not limited to providing round the clock support and accessibility toward resolving any and all critical fingerprint issues; to act as a liaison between ISP and FBI to advocate for any delayed or outstanding prints and to provide status reports

reports pertaining to the number of persons fingerprinted and submission of payment to both ISP and FBI.

- Perform ongoing fingerprinting services at locations designated by the Board.
