

APPROVE COMBINING AND EXERCISING THE SECOND AND THIRD OPTIONS TO RENEW THE EXISTING AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS EXTERNAL PARTNERS TO PROVIDE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND SERVICES TO CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Approve combining and exercising the second and third options to renew the existing agreements with various community based agencies and universities listed in Exhibit A-4 ("Partners") to continue to have them provide to the

22 Chicago Public Schools listed in Exhibit A-1 ("Partner Schools"), after-school programs and services for the Office of Extended Learning Opportunities at a cost not to exceed \$5,000,000 in the aggregate for the 2-year renewal term.

(Centers) may provide activities designed to familiarize parents with issues pertaining to school; or Centers may conduct English as a Second Language classes, Adult Basic Education classes, and Parenting classes. Partners may also give parents opportunities to tutor or volunteer


