OUTCOMES: The hearing officers shall render impartial recommendations to the Chief Education Officer or his designee.

COMPENSATION: For expulsion and truancy hearings, the hearing officers shall be paid as follows: a) \$75.00 per completed hearing and submission of a written report, including a summary of the evidence and a recommendation; and b) \$25.00 for every hearing assigned but canceled or postponed without 48
notification. For tuition residency and Board Rules 6.00, 6.00 and 6.00 hearings, the hearing officers
