**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:**

That the Board approve requirements for the establishment and operation of the advisory body of the Chicago Academy Elementary School

**DESCRIPTION:** Chicago Academy Elementary School was established in September 2003 under Board Report 03-0924-ED02. Chicago Academy, in partnership with the Academy of Urban School Leadership, operates a dual mission: teacher training school where master teachers mentor novice teachers, resident

- (6) Make advisory recommendations to the school improvement plan prepared and administered by the Principal.
- (7) Make advisory recommendations to the expenditure plan prepared and administered by the Principal.
- (8) Prepare and disseminate a detailed annual report to the school community that summarizes

- (9) Make advisory recommendations to the Principal for appointments to fill vacant, additional, or newly created teacher positions at Chicago Academy Elementary School.
- (10) Make advisory recommendations to the principal concerning textbook selection and curriculum

**IV. Other Requirements:**

The provisions of the Board's Policy on Governance of Alternative and Small Schools related to candidate eligibility, appointments, reappointments, and removal of members shall apply to the Chicago Academy

Elementary School ALSC to the extent not inconsistent with the terms of this Board Report.
