

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ALLIED WASTE TRANSPORTATION IN
ALLIED WASTE SERVICES OF CHICAGO FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING
SERVICES FOR ALL CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Chicago to provide solid waste disposal and recycling services for all Chicago Public Schools services at a cost not to exceed \$24,880,413.00. Vendor was selected on a competitive basis pursuant to a duly advertised Request for Proposal (Specification No. # 07-250006). A written agreement for Vendor's services is currently

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COMPENSATION: Consultant shall be paid as follows: upon invoicing based upon the pricing set forth in agreement; not to exceed the sum of \$4,502,728 in Year 1, \$4,727,864 in Year 2, \$4,964,257 in Year 3, \$5,212,470 in Year 4, \$5,473,094 in Year 5, payable in equal monthly installments.

RECYCLING REVENUE: Consultant shall pay the Board 25% of the average price of Old Corrugated Cardboard multiplied by the total tonnage of all clean recyclable material received from the Board during the previous calendar quarter.

REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES: None.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Council to include other relevant terms and conditions in the

written agreement. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreement. Authorize Chief Operation Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this agreement.

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY: The Board of Directors shall be responsible for the implementation of the agreement.
