

**CERTAIN POSITIONS AS "SPECIAL NEEDS" POSITIONS
PURSUANT TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION'S RESIDENCY POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Chicago Board of Education ("Board") has the power to require its employees to
