

**RESCIND BOARD REPORT 95-1220-PO1  
AND ADOPT A NEW POLICY ON BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS, PHYSICAL RESTRAINTS AND**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:**

That the Board rescind Board Report 95-1220-PO1 and adopt a new policy on Behavioral Interventions,

**III. Isolated Time Outs**

A. "Isolated Time Out" refers to the confinement of a student in a time out room or some other enclosure whether inside or outside the classroom from which the student's egress is restricted.

B. Use of isolated time out is prohibited. This restriction does not apply to ISBE-approved educational or residential facilities under contract with the Board to provide educational programming to appropriately identified students, when such use is outlined in a student's IEP.

**IV. Compliance**

School staff shall employ Behavior Interventions and Physical Restraints in accordance with the requirements of this Policy and the procedures and guidelines issued by the Chief Executive Officer or

designee.


Violations of this Policy, or the procedures and guidelines issued by the Chief Executive Officer or designee, are subject to discipline in accordance with the Board's Employee Discipline and Due Process


