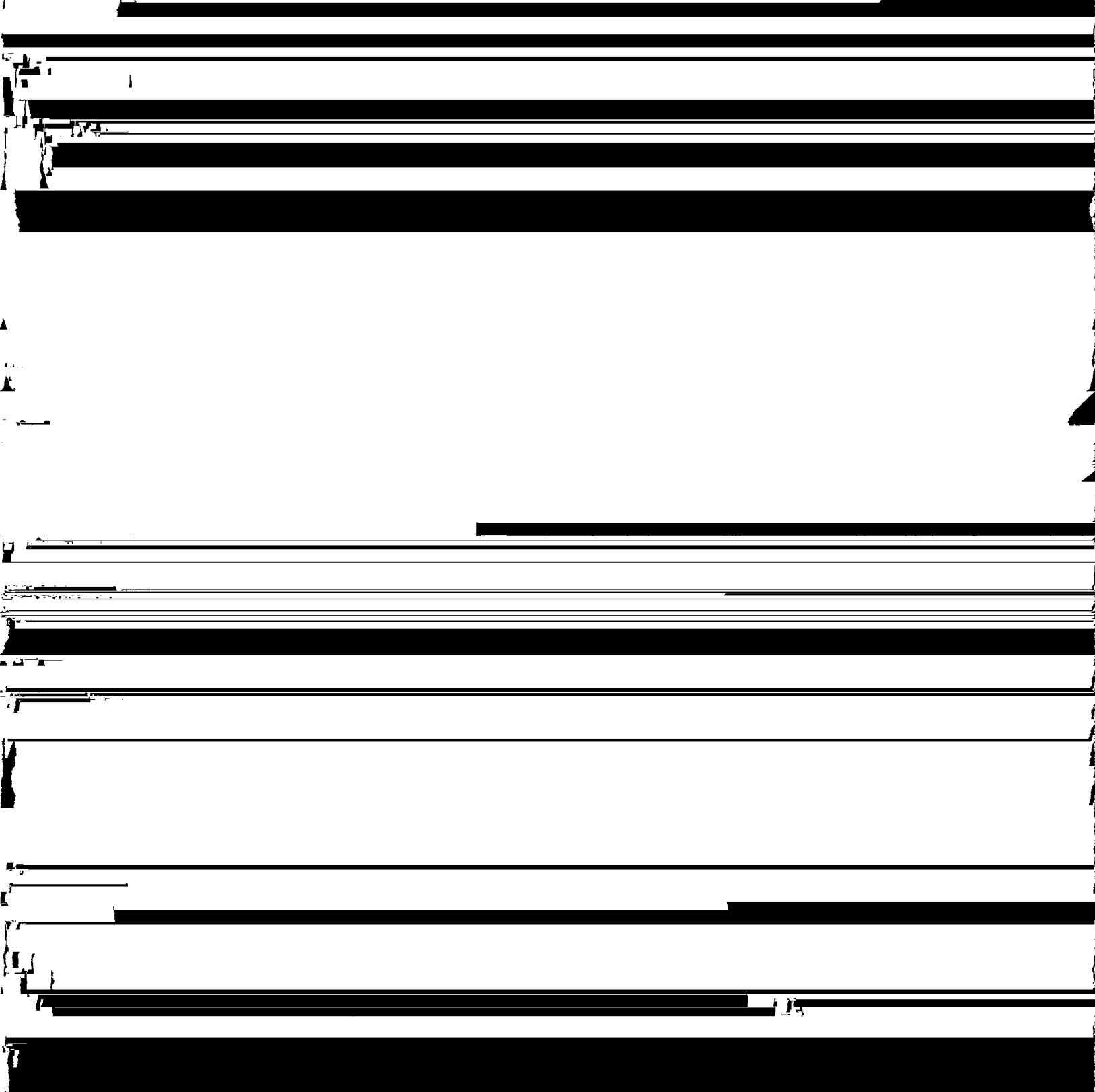
THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into a software license and services agreement with The Library Corporation ("TLC") for an

integrated, district-wide library automation system and related services for use by the Chicago Public Schools

manually performing the circulation and cataloging functions of running a library. This change enables them to spend more time working with students and collaborating with teachers.

Collection development: Schools and the Board can use the system to identify collection gaps, determine collection age, and understand resource usage trends, thereby driving better purchasing decisions. In addition, librarians can electronically share collection information with other librarians, considering similar purchases
