APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ORACLE CORPORATION FOR PEOPLESOFT

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Oracle Corporation to provide consulting services to the Department of Human Resources, Department of Finance, and the Office of Information and Technology.

Services at a cost not to exceed \$250,000.00. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because the professional development services are related to the PeopleSoft Human Capital Management software which was developed by Oracle/PeopleSoft. Oracle/PeopleSoft is the only vendor that provides the unique expert professional development required to train technical resources to maintain the software. A written agreement for Consultant's services is currently being negotiated. No services

OUTCOMES:

Consultant's services will result in CPS employees being trained in the utilization of the PeopleSoft modules listed above.

COMPENSATION:

Consultant shall be paid as follows: a cost of \$35,000.00 per group class dependent upon underlying product module and duration of class as set out in the written agreement, total not to exceed the sum of \$250,000.00.


