**I. Purpose and Goals**


~~Consistent with the Federal and State laws created to address the need for students to receive~~

minimum of 675 instructional minutes per academic year (10 lessons total). For all other grade levels, each course provided in accordance with this policy shall satisfy the minimum instructional minutes requirements set out in the Family Life Guidelines.

However, No student who provides a timely written objection from his or her parents or guardians shall be required to participate in any CDS family life and comprehensive sexual health education program or course


and no student shall be suspended or expelled for refusal to participate in any such program or course. Any


