academic performance and decrease inappropriate behaviors by implementing academic curriculum, social/behavior interventions, vocational and career training opportunities, and life-skills training that are affective, creative, and innovative.

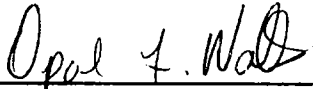

Chief Officer of High School Programs to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate these agreements.

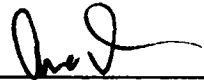

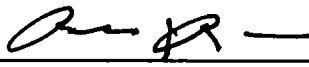
