

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH AT&T DATACOMM, INC. FOR
INTERNET ACCESS SERVICES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with AT&T Datacomm, Inc. ("AT&T") to provide Internet access services to Information & Technology Services ("ITS") at a total cost not to exceed \$814,106.70 for a 41-month (three years and five month) term, of which approximately \$649,291.83 is the discounted portion of eligible E-Rate services and/or products to be funded by the School and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC"). The Board shall only be responsible for the full

price of the first five months of service and for the non-discounted portion of E-Rate eligible services

DELIVERABLES: AT&T will provide the Board with the following deliverables meeting the Board's specified requirements:

- Internet utilization reports
- Service-level agreement report
- Diagram of Internet connections

OUTCOMES: AT&T will provide additional Internet bandwidth for the Board so that the Board

can continue to utilize the Internet unimpeded by slowness or other issues. This will allow for the Board to
