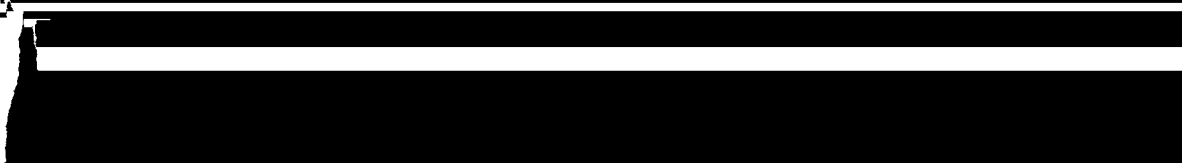

Inspector General. Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS
