Strategic planning support for high schools

Implement and provide strategic planning support for non-classroom teachers

The seven high schools will be evaluated using the Danielson Framework


**COMPENSATION:**

Consultant shall be paid as follows: An onsite consultant will be dedicated to CDE for 50 days of work at

a daily rate of \$950.00. Additional consultants will be compensated at a daily rate of \$1,500 per trainer
