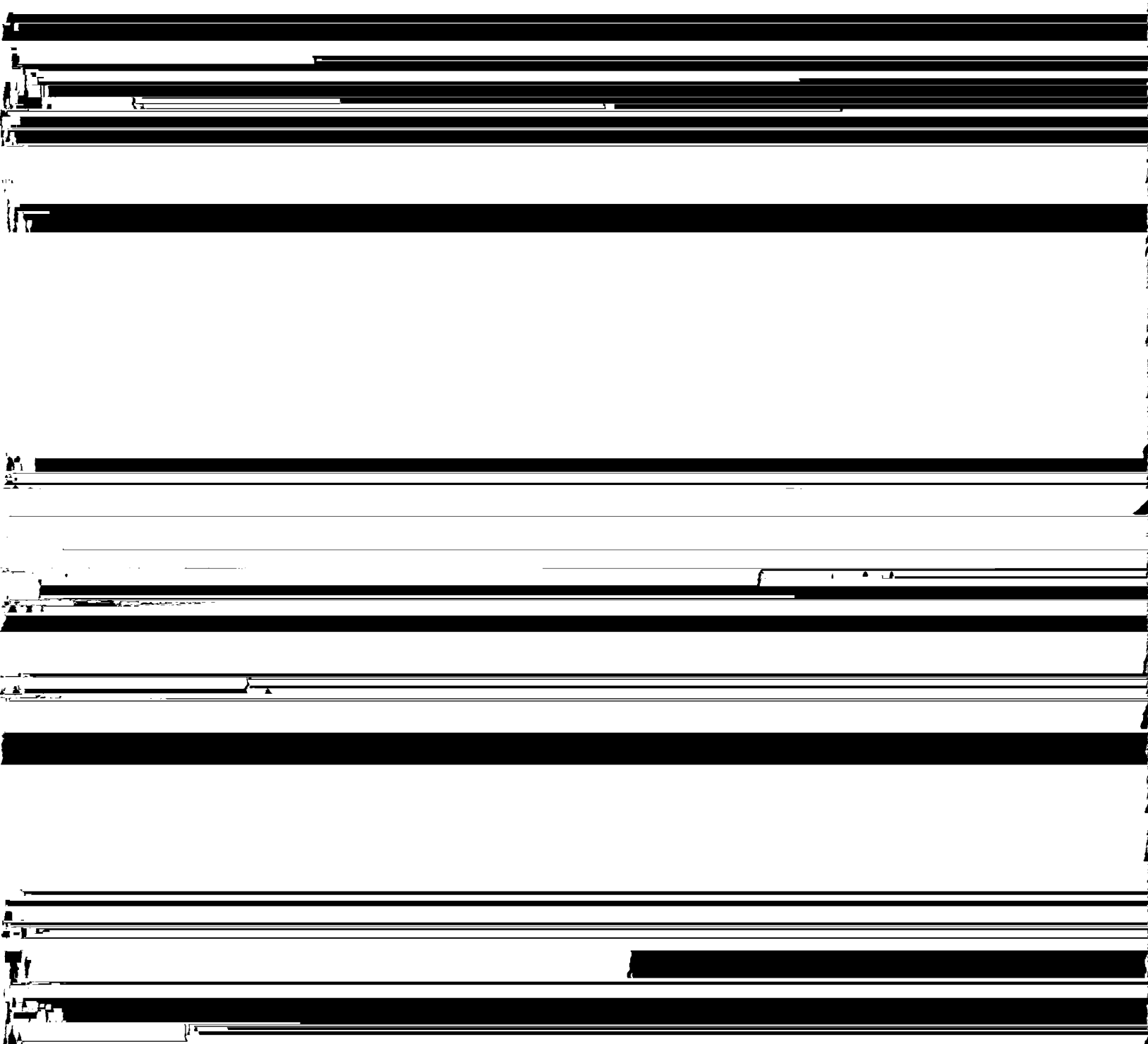
THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATION:

Agreement with Children's Memorial Hospital for \$1,000,000.00 for staff development and student support for the Department of Office of School Improvement.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: The Board shall have the right to terminate each agreement with 30 days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Children's Memorial Hospital (CMH) provide training and ongoing technical assistance to the Care Teams at each school. One CMH representative (psychologist or social worker) is assigned to each of our high schools. They will provide ongoing support to the clinicians regarding the implementation of these targeted interventions. They also work closely with the Care Team Leader at each school to ensure that the Care Team intake/triage process is efficient and that students in Care



GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/24-10.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain

investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.


Conflicts – the agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the

provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of

office.


