

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION OF CHICAGO FOR THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW ENHANCED SECURITY CAMERA PROJECT FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:**

Approve entering into an intergovernmental agreement with the Public Building Commission of Chicago to undertake the design and installation of a new enhanced camera system for CPS schools. A written intergovernmental agreement is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided and no payment shall be made prior to the execution of the intergovernmental agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event an intergovernmental agreement is not executed within 120 days of the date of this Board Report. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former
